Menu will include bagels, toppings, fruit, juice, and pretzels.

Adult volunteers may help set up food, monitor lunch and washing.

Please note that lunch will be served to children, ages 3-6,

in the upstairs double classroom by the babysitting staff.

There is a fee for Yomim Noraim babysitting but all other children's programming is free for LMS children and their visiting relatives. Babysitting must be paid for and reserved in advance to ensure adequate staff is hired.
